An Exhibition on the SHROUD of TURIN will begin at St Francis Xavier's Church, Hereford on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> June running until Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> June.

It opens with a talk from international expert, Pam Moon, at 3pm on 15<sup>th</sup> June.

Do come along to learn about the burial cloth of Jesus which was mentioned in all four Gospels. Is the Turin Shroud one and the same shroud?; A life-size photograph of the shroud which has confounded experts,; been venerated by Popes, studied by scientists and survived four fires forms a part of the Exhibition. Parish pilgrimages welcome, by arrangement, with refreshments provided and a talk by local expert.
